### Heartbeat for Ministry

(part 3 of 3)

Hi friends. Today I am writing the final part of a three-part blog series sharing a document that Diane and I wrote eight years ago when we reviewed our core values. We called it our “Heartbeat for Ministry.” Once again, I remind you here that my purpose for this series is three-fold: to be a) more fully known to you, the dear people I share life with, b) to invite your accountability to live these words more completely, and c) to inspire you to identify and fulfill your own core values while you still have the strength and will to do so.

So now to the heartbeat; we pick it up with #10.

10. We believe that a church that cares for widows, orphans, the poor, the imprisoned, the hurting, the sick, and the disenfranchised is a church that is practicing “pure religion” and is pleasing to the Lord Jesus Christ (James 1:27). We desire to be part of a body of believers that has an “outward glance” to those people

that Jesus came to seek and save.

11. For the past decade, we have been practicing the art of “ministering together.” We are both called to serving the Lord and His Church. We have shared ministry that has included pre-marital and marital counseling, speaking together, visitation, leading small groups and hospitality in our home. Also, we try to support each other in our own areas of influence as well as our specific places of assignment and responsibility; both inside and outside the Church.

12. Successful leadership is a fine balance between being a courageous and bold leader along with being a teachable and humble follower. Ultimately, leadership is influence, but successful and godly leadership is influencing others to fulfill the Great Commission and the Great Commandment.

Under pressure, a leader might resort to being either a) rigid, autocratic and strong handed or b) abdicate their role of leadership and become a manager at best and a puppet at worst.

Pastoring involves balancing the roles of leading and shepherding. If a pastor “shepherds” without leading, they are more of a chaplain. If a pastor “leads” without shepherding, they are more of a boss. There is only one “Lead Shepherd” in the Church; Jesus Christ. Everyone else is an under-shepherd. The specific responsibilities of an under-shepherd that is in the role of senior pastor, although different from other roles, must be used to serve the church.

I, Shaun, am endeavoring to be a Shepherd-Leader. I am learning how to both serve and lead I believe that what the Lord intends to feed the flock, He usually feeds the Shepherd first. I am committed to receive what the Lord gives me and to pass that along to the flock as best as I am able, the Lord being my helper. He is faithful!

Thank you for taking time to read these thoughts. Both Diane and I hope and pray you will know how very much the Lord loves you and that you will find freedom to live your lives fully for God. Stay the course!


