### Heartbeat for Ministry

(part 1 of 3)

In 2010, Diane and I were in transition from our assignment of pastoring in Newberg, Oregon. It took us many months to discern that God was writing a new chapter in the story of our lives and leading us to a new land. We were in the “in-between” and wondered what was next. During that time, we reviewed our core values and wrote what we called our: Heartbeat for Ministry. We gave this personal manifesto to the Conference and Church leaders when we interviewed for the role of Senior Pastor here at QFMC.

Now, eight years removed from the original writing, we still hold to this as an accurate testimony of our heartbeat. I will parcel it out over my next three blog posts with a desire to be a) more fully known to you, the dear people I share life with, b) to invite your accountability to live these words more completely, and c) to inspire you to identify and fulfill your own core values while you still have the strength and will to do

so.

So, without further ado, here is part 1 of 3 of Shaun & Diane's Heartbeat for Ministry.

1. We want to love God and love others. Personally, we are endeavoring to live the Great Commandment (Matthew 22:36-39) and answer the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20); we are committed to helping others do the same.
2. We have a passion for those who don't yet know Christ. We consider them the "cherished missing." Our desire is to be part of a church (people who are called to this purpose) that focuses on the people who are not yet our people. This focus must also be in balance with the discipling of those who are our people. (Romans 10:5-15 and Matthew 28:18-20)
3. We desire to be part of a healthy inter-generational body of believers where the message about Jesus does not change but the methods for worshipping and proclaiming Jesus are many. We are motivated and chronologically positioned to encourage, and release those generations before and after us into community and ministry.
4. We believe that every believer is made to be filled with the Holy Spirit. We also believe that the Holy Spirit continues to give the Church the gifts that have been given since Acts 2. People are like sails on a sail boat. Each sail is unique and designed for specific purposes, yet every sail on every sailboat has one primary purpose; to catch the wind. Each believer is unique and has specific gifts and purposes. Each believer is designed to catch the wind of the Holy Spirit. We celebrate the unique gifts that the Holy Spirit gives the Lord's Church and the ways in which each person "catches the wind" of the Spirit. In this way the body of Christ can be built up and edified. (Acts 1-2, Romans 12, 1 Corinthians 12-14, Galatians 5:16-26, Ephesians 5:15-20)
