### Heartbeat for Ministry

(part 2 of 3)

Last week, I began a three-part blog series sharing a document that Diane and I wrote eight years ago when we reviewed our core values. We called it our “Heartbeat for Ministry.” I remind you here that my purpose for this series is three-fold: to be a) more fully known to you, the dear people I share life with, b) to invite your accountability to live these words more completely, and c) to inspire you to identify and fulfill your own core values while you still have the strength and will to do so.

Now I continue with # 5 in our Heartbeat for Ministry.

5. We were profoundly impacted and encouraged by Bishop Roger Haskins’ address to the FMC in 2003. In that address, He said that the Lord was giving His Holy Spirit to the Church in these days. He exhorted to us to not “say no to the Holy Spirit” as we had in the past. He taught us that all things were to be done with discernment,

balance, and passion.

Regarding the gifts and the fruit of the Holy Spirit; both are good. We are for pursuing love and desiring the gifts and special abilities that the Spirit gives (1 Corinthians 14). We are also for producing much spiritual fruit that lasts (John 15:1-17 and Galatians 5:16-26). Manifestations of the Holy Spirit are good and should not necessarily be disallowed in the Church, yet manifestations do not make for an adequate measuring stick of spiritual maturity. Spiritual fruit is the ultimate goal of the Church and is the best measuring stick of spiritual maturity. Spiritual gifts, manifestations, and fruit are best when together and in balance.

6. The Word of God is central in our lives. We believe it should be central in the Church. We believe that reason, tradition, and experience are important in interpreting the Word, but it is the Word that both takes precedence, and guides our reason, tradition, and experience. We desire to help others make the Word (both the reading and doing) a central part of their lives. (2 Timothy 2:14-17 and James 1:25)

7. Christians who have mostly Spirit but little or no Word are in danger of “burning up.” Christians who have mostly Word but little or no Spirit are in danger of “blowing up.” Christians who have both the Word and Spirit will most likely “grow up.”

8. Living personal holiness is important to us. We are not inclined to make rules for others. We are attempting to live the balance that Jesus modeled when “The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us... full of grace and truth.” (John 1:14)

We believe that Christians are free in Christ and that legalism kills. Likewise, we are trying to avoid compromise with the world. Compromise also kills. Freedom and life come as a result of living in submission to Christ and following the leading of the Holy Spirit into the balance of “grace and truth.” Community with other believers is the very best place to grow in holiness. Community that includes the Word, worship, and service to others is the fertile soil for growth.

9. We believe that a good working definition of sanctification is when a follower of Jesus Christ loves God and loves others, more and more.

May the Lord bless you as you follow Him in faith-obedience.


