My Dad

I wish I could introduce you to my dad. He passed away in 2005 in the middle of his 84th year. He was one of the very best men I've ever known, and he was my hero. I think you would have liked him and I'm certain he would have liked you.

John "Jack" Dauphine McNay was born on September 19, 1920 in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan Canada. As a boy he joined the Boy Scouts when it was just a fledgling organization and discovered a love for the outdoors. Like most Canadian boys he learned to skate at a young age and played hockey (he even toured Europe with the Canadian Army Team after WW2). His sisters, Margaret and Betty, adored their only brother in part because he treated them like they were royalty.

When England declared war on Germany in 1939, the nations of the British Common Wealth (including Canada) stood with them in opposing Nazi oppression and tyranny. My dad was 19 when he became a soldier and was 26 when he returned home from

Europe. I have always marveled at how gentle he was in spite of all the horrors he saw and endured during World War 2.

He was a Staff Sargent in a tank recovery unit. When he returned home, he found a job working as a parts man in a car dealership. He made that his life long career. I have many memories of my dad taking a call after hours from a motorist who was broken down and in need of one part or another. He seemed to have an endless supply of patience. He redefined “service with a smile” and won many return customers because he treated people with respect and honor. I wish you could have known my dad. I think you would have liked him and I’m certain he would have liked you.

I can’t remember my dad saying a negative thing about anyone. He was able to find something positive in each individual. It was from him that I first learned that each person has value and worth, even if they don’t always act like it. He was an example of perseverance, kindness, and integrity. People respected my dad because of the way he treated them.

With Father’s Day approaching, I have had my dad on my mind. I look forward to being reunited with him some day. He was a follower of Jesus and I am confident that I will see him again. I wish you could have known my dad. I think you would have liked him and I’m certain he would have liked you.

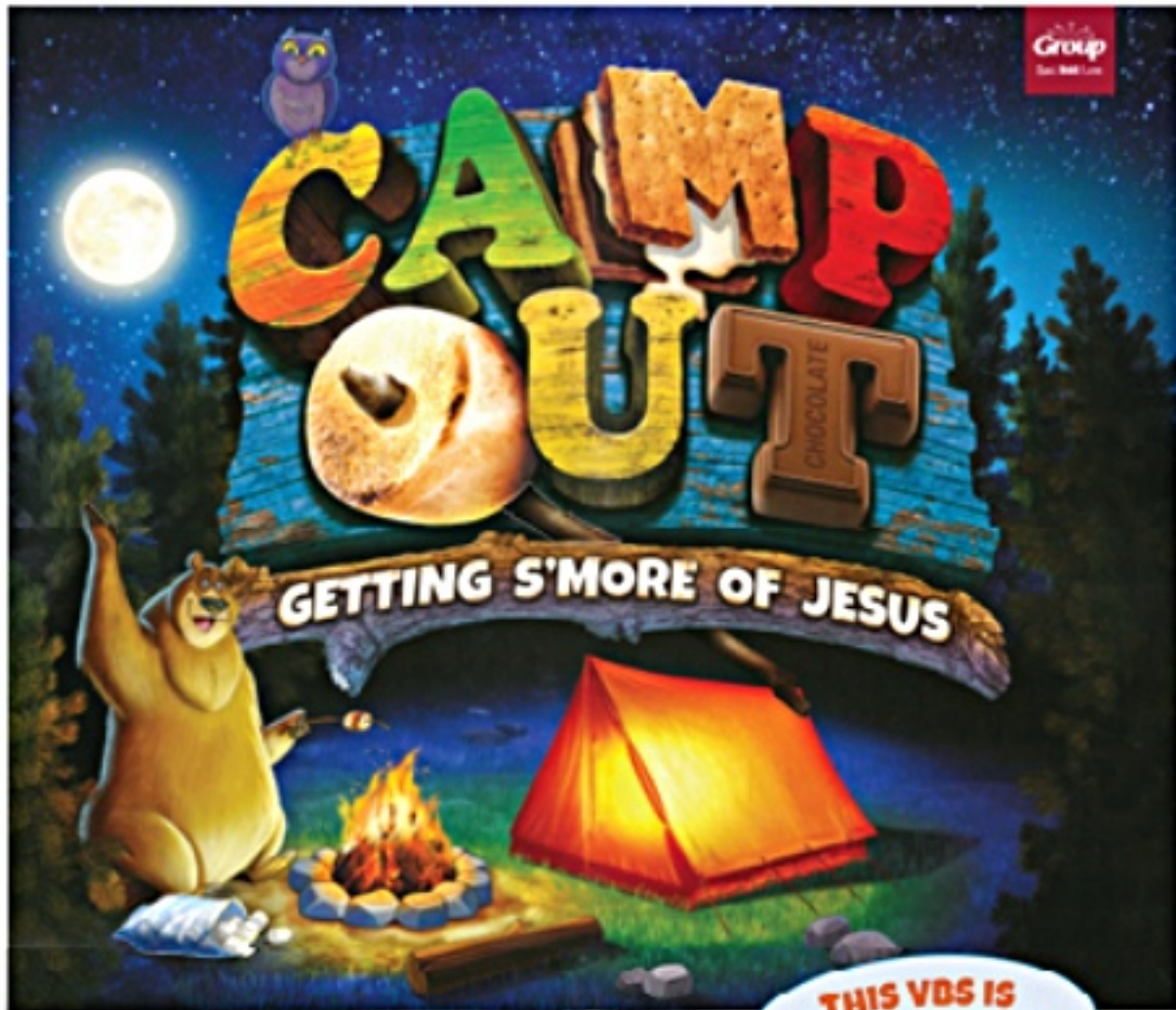

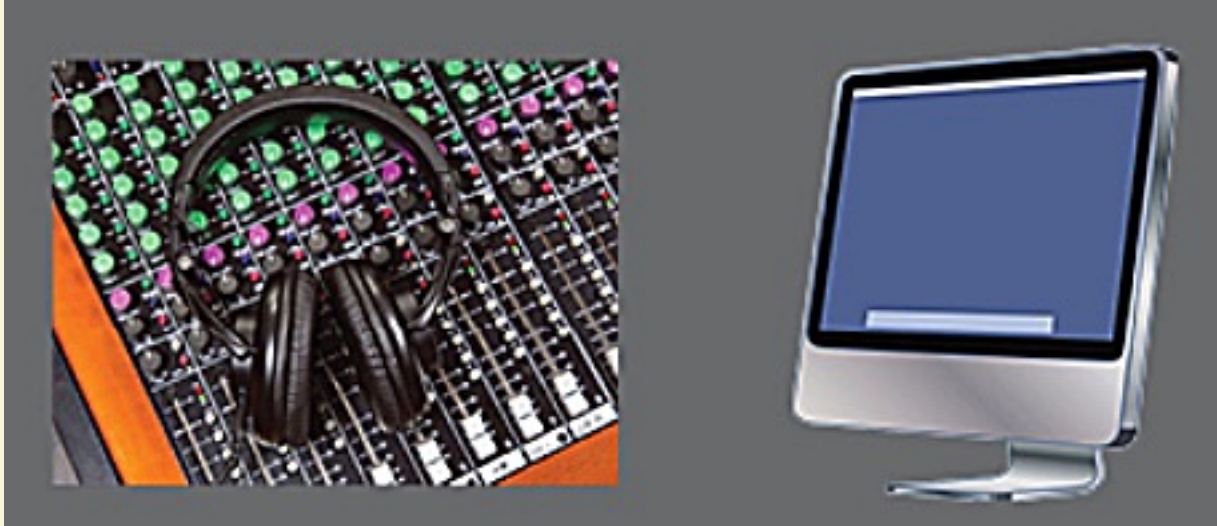
