Quote #1 comes from Lannette Melburn...

Quote #3 comes from Andrew Royer...

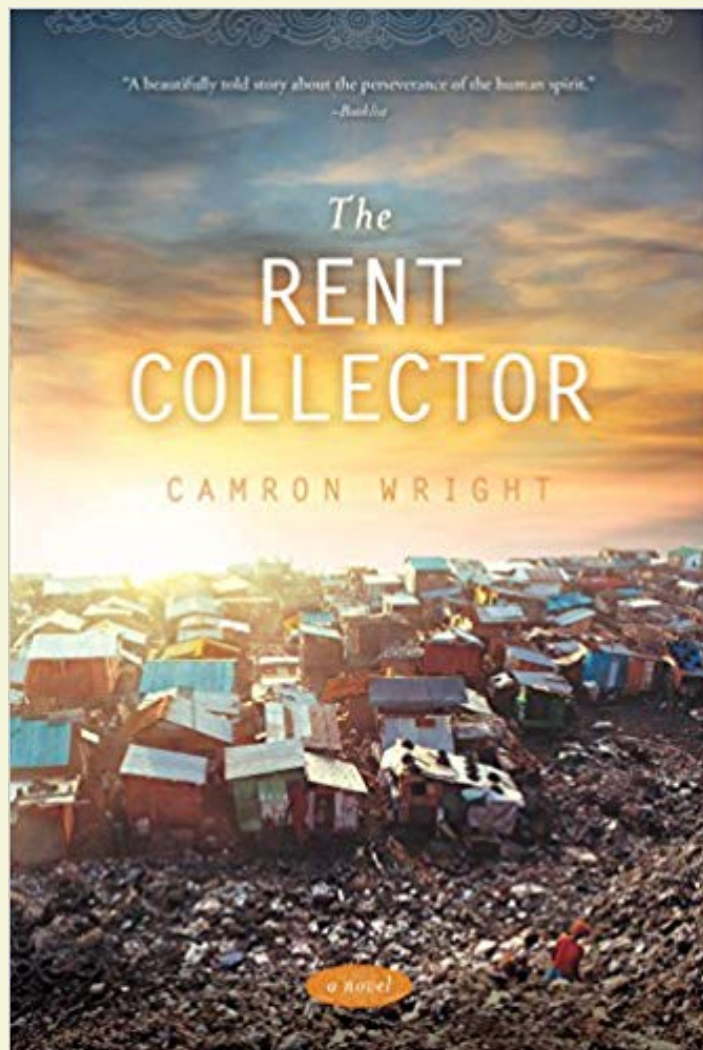
