## Success

Each morning, the first communication I receive is a text message from the YouVersion Bible App on my phone. Yesterday the verse was Proverbs 16:3, "Commit your actions to the Lord, and your plans will succeed."

One of the greatest privileges of being a pastor is that I am allowed to hear people's stories. Often times I am also asked for guidance and counsel. Long before I ever thought to be a pastor, I went to graduate school to get a degree in counseling. I intentionally chose to study counseling at a seminary. My thinking was as follows: God is the source of wisdom; the Bible is the most reliable source of revelation of God; if I am going to help people find wisdom for their lives, then I need to learn how to study the Bible, as well as learning counseling theory and practice, then I will be better able to help them discern God's wisdom for their life.

When I read scripture like the one I quoted earlier, I am reminded that God has

indeed given us a reliable source to help us discern His will. Here is how I processed Proverbs 16:3...

- When it comes to success, there is “my part” and there is “God’s part.”
- My part is, “committing my actions to the Lord.”
- God’s part is, “the success.”
- I’m confident that God can take care of His portion.
- I am not as confident that I can manage my part.

So how do we commit our actions to the Lord? Here are a few practices that I can recommend:

- Fasting and prayer
- Reading and meditating on God’s Word
- Regularly worship and fellowship with other Christians
- Sacrificial giving of tithes and offering to God
- Serving others
- Seek wise counsel

Are you wanting success this coming year? The Word gives true and reliable counsel; our part is to “commit your actions to the Lord,” the Lord will take care of the success!

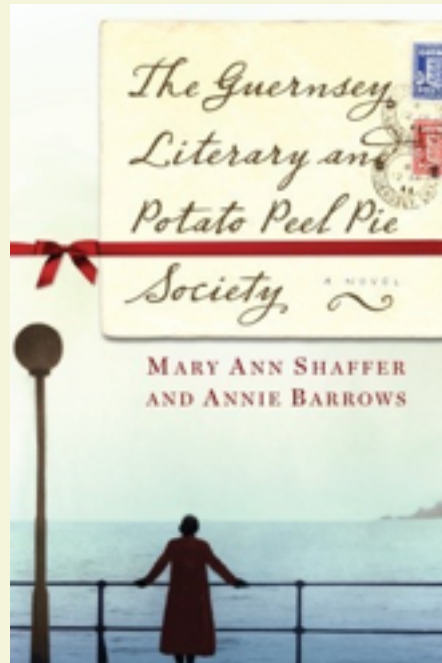
