









# Saul at Damascus and Jerusalem

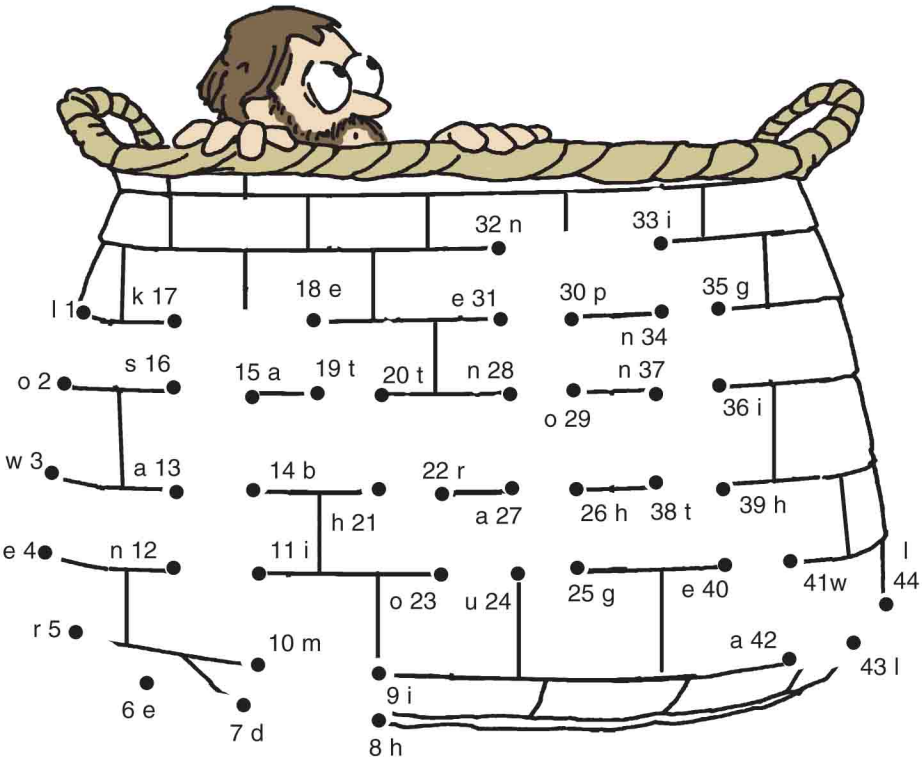
